

## Data privacy information

We take the protection of your personal data very seriously. Therefore we will inform you below about how we handle your personal data, and the rights you have towards us in respect of the use of the data.

### 1. Data processor

a) *Name and contact data of the company (person responsible)*

### 2. Processing scope

a) *Categories of personal data processed*

We process the following categories of data: address data, contact data, bank details, creditworthiness information, accounting data, contract data, customer interests.

b) *Data source*

The creditworthiness information is provided to us by IHD Kreditschutzverein e.V.

c) *Storage period*

Three years after termination of the contract with you we will check whether we still need your data. If it is no longer needed and deletion is not prohibited by statutory retention periods the data will be deleted.

d) *Purpose and legal basis of data processing*

We use your data to implement the contractual relationship established with you and for customer support. According to art. 6 para 1 lit. b) DSGVO processing of your data is required for the performance of a contract concluded with you.

e) *Data processing based on legitimate interest*

Besides processing of your data for the implementation of the contractual relationship established with you, we also use your data on the basis of art. 6 para 1 lit. f) DSGVO in order to communicate with you about your orders, certain products or marketing actions, or to recommend you products or services which you might be interested in.

**You can contradict to the use of your personal data for advertising purposes, as a whole or for individual measures, at any time, without incurring any costs other than the transmission costs in accordance with the basic tariffs. A notice in text form to the contact data stated at lit. 1a) (e.g. e-mail, fax, letter) will be sufficient.**

f) *Mandatory provision of data*

Provision of the data is required for the conclusion of a contract with you. If you do not provide the data conclusion of a contract will be impossible.

g) *Automated decision-making*

The decision whether we will conclude a credit agreement with you is based on an automated decision of our system. A manual review of your documents by one of our employees will not take place. The decision about the conclusion of a credit agreement will be made by

our system solely on the basis of the result of the credit assessment carried out on our behalf by IHD Kreditschutzverein e.V. as service provider. For a credit assessment, a so-called score value is calculated using a mathematical method which provides information about your solvency. We transmit your personal data and your address data to IHD Kreditschutzverein e.V. for the purpose of the credit assessment. You can object to the provision of the data to IHD Kreditschutzverein e.V. at any time.

In case of a positive credit assessment a contract can be concluded with you. If the credit assessment is negative, our system will not accept conclusion of a contract with you.

The scope of the automated decision is solely restricted to the decision whether a credit agreement will be concluded

with you. We use the automated decision exclusively to protect ourselves from the risk of payment defaults.

### 3. Transfer and external relation

a) *Data recipients*

We transfer personal data to third parties only if this is necessary for the implementation of a contract, if you expressly agreed to the data transfer beforehand, if we are obliged to do so by reason of law or any official or court order, or if this is required to enforce our rights, in particular to enforce claims from the contractual relationship with you. We will transfer the data to the following categories of recipients, if this is required for the implementation of the contract:

- public authorities which receive data on the basis of legal provisions (e.g. financial authorities);
- internal bodies involved in the execution of the respective business processes;
- external bodies, such as affiliated companies of Sitron Sensor GmbH and external contractors used for correct settlement of transactions (e.g. carriers, banks, cloud service providers).

b) *Transfer to third countries*

We do not transfer personal data to any third country.

### 4. Rights of the persons affected

a) *Right of access, rectification, deletion, restriction of processing and data portability*

You are entitled to receive on request information concerning the personal data stored in relation to your person free of charge. In addition, you have a right to rectification or deletion of this data, to restriction of data processing and data portability in accordance with the statutory regulations.
